He married (2) ISABELLA F MOODIE 5 April 1869 in Perth, Ontario, daughter of JOHN MOODIE and JEANETTE ANDERSON. She was born 27 September 1845, and died 3 March 1926.

" Henry Houze took over the Ireland blacksmith shop which he bought fr om Joseph Willis in 1868. Unlike the previous blacksmiths, Houze thri ved and expanded his enterprise in the village. He came to the villag e from Perth, already an experienced man in the trade, in his early th irties. During the 1880s Houze exchanged his land for that owned by th e Gilday brothers, carriagemakers near Klyne's hotel. Houze also bough t another property from Thomas Gilday across the street from the old s hop next to O'Reilly's hotel. Houze tore down the old forge that was o nce run by James Ireland in 1888 and later built a frame house on the site. He had a carriage house and wood shed built on his new property across the street. At this point, Houze operated both a blacksmith an d a carriagemaking shop in Lombardy. The former was run by Robert Clar k, who later started his own, and the latter by John Munroe, who had w orked for Houze for about twenty years from the 1870s.

Like so many people in villages and in the country, Houze was the vict im of fire. In 1893, the paint shop of his carriagemaking business wa s destroyed. Nothing was saved, and he had no insurance on the propert y. The fire spread to the cheese factory operated by the O'Maras but i t was promptly extinguished. Houze made do for a while in an old buil ding before rebuilding the carriage works that year. Houze continued t o work until the turn of the century when he turned over his business to his son, George. Henry Houze died in 1904."

"I ... believe Maud May Houe (b 17 Aug 1875) was the youngest daughter of John Houe and Mary Ann Warrington. She was born about the time Mary Ann died, (possibly in childbirth?) The 1881 census showed her with Henry's family, and her marriage record indicated he was her father; however, several obituaries listed her as John's daughter, and I believe Henry might have raised her after her mother died."

1901 census, Elma, Perth, Ontario shows age as 60, b 9 May 1841, Ontario. Head, Farmer, Methodist, As there are 10 years between his last two children, it is wondered if he might have married twice, or else lost several children in between.

1911 online census, Elma, p 3, household #26, shows John & Frances living Lot 15, Concession 1 or H. John is Head, b May 1840, age 71, b Ontario, Farmer, C of E?. Frances b August 1850, age 62?, b Ontario, C of E?. Image is VERY poor quality.

Charles and Ellen McManes, parents of Frances were living in Perth Co. in 1881, as was William Houe, brother of John (household 213 in the census). This may explain how John and Frances connected and why they were married in Newry,

Perth Co. in 1877. They may also have known each other as the McManes were originally in Bathurst Township, Lanark County. The family connection would also explain why Annabella Houze married her step-cousin.

Henry farmed on what is now the Tower Road, but in 1929 when Earl - their sixth child - was four years old, the family moved to a 300-acre farm on the Bay Road which is now owned by Earl's brother Osborne Covell. For schooling, the Covell children crossed the fields and the #15 highway to attend the SS 5 schoolhouse where the Glen Eagle golf course now is. For high school (which he attended only briefly) Earl went into Smiths Falls by horse and buggy with elder brother Osborne.

Earl joined the army in 1942 and was stationed in England for three years. He then worked for the CPR for two years before going into construction carpentry. When Earl and Isobel were married, they moved into the house on the Rideau Ferry Road just outside Rideau Ferry which Earl had built for them. This was on property bought from the Wills family. At Christmas, Isobel was engaged to teach at the Lombardy school and continued there until their first son, Kenyon Covell, was born. Isobel then did some supply teaching but did not care for it and indeed there was enough for her to do with a growing family and the book-keeping for Earl's growing business. In 1963 the Covells established a retail business in building supplies to complement the construction business.
