History of Coltness Estate and Coltness House

The area was originally part of the extensive estates of the Sommervilles of Cambusnethan. Their lands, which stretched to the River Clyde were sold off to pay debts. Coltness was eventually purchased by Sir Walter Stewart in 1653. The 18th century economist James Denham-Steuart lived out his last years here. The estate remained with the Stewarts of Allanton and Coltness until 1840 when trustees sold it to the Houldsworths, a family of newly wealthy industrialists who lived in the imposing Coltness House until the 1950s. The mansion then became a residential school run by Barnardo's until the late 1970s when it was used briefly as a refugee resettlement centre for Vietnamese Boat People. The building lay empty for several years, was badly vandalised and severely damaged in a fire. It was eventually demolished in the early 1980s to make way for the Woodlandsgate estate built by Barratt Homes. The former stables of Coltness House were retained and converted to flats.
