MORRISON - On the evening of Thursday, Jan 23rd, there passed away one of the sweetest and most devoted women in the person of Mrs. Morrison, widow of the late James Morrison of Oliver's Ferry. The charming personality, the quiet unassuming manner, but above all the beautiful mature Christian character were an inspiration to all who had the privilege of knowing Mrs. Morrison. As a personal friend she was beloved by every one. In time of sickness or need she was almost invariably called. She never failed to respond or do efficient service. The community has sustained a great loss in her removal. The illness which terminated on January 23rd was of a very distressing character. For a year past Mrs. Morrison suffered from paralysis of the lower extremities, brought on apparently by anaemia. She could not so much as shift her position without assistance. This long illness she bore with such Christian patience and resignation that she often put others to shame. She was a very active member of Bethel Church, Oliver's Ferry, ever since its organization in 1886. Previous to that she belonged to St. Andrew's, Perth. Mrs. Morrison was twice married. Her first husband was Mr. James Coutts, of Oliver's Ferry. She is survived by two sons and two daughters, George Coutts who resides near Davidson, Sask.; James Coutts, Miss Martha Coutts and Miss Magie Morrison all of Oliver's Ferry. Her nearest living relatives are Donald McIntosh, of New Lisgard, Dr. McIntosh and James McIntosh, of Carleton Place, brothers, and Mrs. Goldie, of Foam Lake, Sask., and Mrs. Latimer of Carleton Place, sisters. The funeral took place on Sunday last, public service being held in the church here an appropriate sermon was preached to a very large congregation by the pastor, Rev. W.T.B. Crombie M.A. B.D., from 2nd Pet., 11th.
